Recommend Board adoption of the 2024 – 2025 Budget:

WHEREAS, the Interlaken Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 11, 2024 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 11, 2024 and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Asbury Park Press on April 19, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the final budget was presented to the public during a hearing held at the Interlaken Borough Hall, Interlaken, NJ, on the 6th of May 2024.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Interlaken Board of Education hereby adopts the following 2024-2025 Final Budget:

#### **Adjustment for Enrollment**

BE IT RESOLVED that the Interlaken Board of Education includes in the final budget the adjustment for enrollment in the amount of \$116,094. The district intends to utilize this adjustment for tuition necessary for additional students.

#### **Travel and Related Expense Reimbursements**

WHEREAS, the Interlaken Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel as defined in N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-1.2, which includes attendance at regularly scheduled in-State county meetings, Department or Association sponsored events or in-State professional development activities for which the registration fee does not exceed \$150.00 per employee or board member, where prior Board approval shall not be required unless the annual threshold for a staff member exceeds \$1,500 in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

WHEREAS, the Interlaken Board of Education established \$500 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$0 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$500 for the 2024-2025 school year.
